

What has LECC done for the Lake Eucumbene region since it began 2002?

(Please note all funding was obtained for local organizations and spent in this area)

- Since Dec 2002 the Chamber has provided an externally recognised contact point for Adaminaby
- Speakers - 2003 to the present:
 - Have an active programme of sourcing relevant speakers to inform members from:
 - All levels of government
 - Corporate, tourism and other entities that have decision making impact on this region.
 - The purpose of this is to:
 - Inform & support members
 - Keep business members up to date with workplace legislation, OH&S etc
 - Have this region recognised and considered as viable by 'outside' entities and
 - Enable members to successfully engage in a meaningful way in all types of situations.
- 2003 and 04 'auspiced' Adaminaby Youth Club grant application \$18,000
- 2003 to present – developed & maintain LECC website which is hosted by local business Ozwebhost
- 2004–09 participated in:
 - Meetings with NSW Cabinet Ministers re important local issues e.g. Bobeyan Road funding, RTA & snow chains
 - NSW Tourism Workshops
 - Coronial Inquest into boating deaths on Lake Eucumbene
 - NSW Legislative Council Enquiry into the future of Snowy Hydro
 - NSW State Plan - invited by NSW Dept. of Premier and Cabinet's Rural Regional Taskforce
 - NSW NPWS 'Centenary Fund Stakeholder' program
 - Economic workshops organised by NSW Department of State and Regional Development
 - Consultations with Snowy River Shire Council and other Chambers located within the Shire
 - South East Area Regional Combined Chambers of Commerce meetings
- 2005-06:
 - Obtained Federal funding to upgrade Memorial Hall \$78,000
 - Lobbied SR Shire Council to set up local s355 Committee to manage upgrade
 - Worked with Hall s355 Committee to get SRSC heritage funding for floor upgrade \$1,800
- From 2005 supported Snowy River Aviators at SR Shire Council with purchase Adaminaby Kennedy airfield
- 2006:
 - Upgraded 'Information Building' near Highway - included donations of local 'in-kind' work & materials
 - Refurbishment of 'Big Trout' – from SRSC & included donations of 'in-kind' work and materials \$10,000
- 2007 – new Xmas Lights funded by Country Energy \$1,000
- 2007 'auspiced' 50th Anniversary of Adaminaby's 'Move' - seed funding provided by SRSC: \$1,500
 - Provided Insurance 'umbrella' for Event
 - Obtained Council DA and 'Risk Analysis' approval
 - Corporate sponsorship of official lunch \$500
- 2007-08 Installed Weather Station and Camera at OA – donated by Snowy Hydro \$2,500
 - This included a lot of local 'in-kind' work and cash donations
- 2007-08 Obtained \$15,000 NSW Dept of State & Regional Development funding with \$5,000 local input:
 - Printed 20,000 glossy A4 8 page Brochures
 - Ran business Information Workshop
 - Printed 'bumper' stickers
 - Developed 'visitadaminaby' website \$20,000
- 'Auspiced' 3 Boat Ramp funding applications:
 - Adaminaby Fishing Club, NSW Maritime (May 2006, \$22,400; April 2009: \$70,300) \$92,700
 - Anglers Reach - boat ramp & signage - NSW Maritime & NSW Fisheries \$30,000
- 2008-09 - Lobbied SR Shire Council for funding to upgrade:
 - Swimming pool \$30,00 & Thermal cover \$5,000 \$35,000
 - Playground near Highway \$5,000
- **Currently:**
 - Working with Coastal Watch to improve video coverage & weather information for Lake Eucumbene
 - Supporting the SRA to help local Scout Group Leader set up facilities for young people
 - Waiting to hear result of EOI for application for \$100,000 wireless broadband system for outlying areas
 - Having regional 'Strategic Plan' written, to prepare for next 5 years (final part of NSW DSRD funding)
 - Recognised as media liaison contact organisation for region
 - The Vice-Chair is a senior member on several influential State Government boards
 - A business member is a local Councillor.
